PROGRAMMES COVERED

- Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes notified by the University for the Academic Year 2026-27 shall be covered under this notification.
- Admissions in to all programmes shall follow applicable norms, approvals, recognitions, and eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENT TO APPEAR

- Candidates must satisfy the minimum educational qualification and subject requirements prescribed for the selected programme, including 10+2 or equivalent qualification for undergraduate programmes and relevant undergraduate qualification for postgraduate programmes, wherever applicable.
- Candidates awaiting final qualifying examination results may apply where permitted, subject to producing required documents before final admission.
- Appearing in SM CET 2026 does not by itself create a right to admission. Admission is subject to eligibility, merit, document verification, seat availability, counselling/interview where applicable, and payment of prescribed fees.

EXAMIN PATTERN AND CANDIDATE GUIDELINES

- The entrance test shall be conducted online for a duration of two hours.
- The test may include objective/subject-based questions as per programme level and discipline. Detailed syllabus and question pattern will be notified separately.
- Candidates must login/report at 9:30 A.M. and follow all admit-card and online portal instructions.
- Candidates must keep valid photo identity proof ready for the test and subsequent verification/counselling.
- Unfair means, impersonation, false information, or violation of instructions may lead to cancellation of candidature/admission and action as per University rules.

SELECTION, COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

- Merit may be prepared based on entrance test performance, qualifying marks, interview/counselling, and/or other criteria as per applicable norms.
- Shortlisted candidates shall attend counselling/document verification as per the University schedule.
- Final admission shall be confirmed only after original document verification, eligibility compliance, fee payment, and applicable statutory/regulatory compliance.

7. SCHOLARSHIPS ALLOCATION CRITERIA

(A) Academic Scholarships

Scholarships may be granted based on performance in St. Mary's Entrance Test - 2026 (SM CET 2026), subject to eligibility, document verification, availability of scholarship seats/funds, and approval by the competent University Committee.

391 & above	100%
381-390	75%
371-380	50%
361-370	25%
351-360	15%
341-350	10%

 **Note:** The above score ranges shall apply with reference to the maximum marks and scholarship rules notified by the University for SM CET 2026.

(B) Scholarships for Students from Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs)

In furtherance of the objectives of the National Education Policy, 2020 and the University's commitment to inclusive access:

Category	Scholarship on Tuition Fee
20% of admitted eligible SEDG students	50% tuition fee waiver
30% of admitted eligible SEDG students	20% tuition fee waiver



• Assistance for educational loans

The University shall facilitate and assist eligible students in applying for educational loans from banks and financial institutions, subject to the respective bank's eligibility norms, documentation requirements, credit appraisal, and sanction process.



Important Conditions:

- The scholarship applies only to tuition fees.
- Students are eligible for only one scholarship; the highest-value scholarship shall apply where more than one category is applicable where ever applicable.
- Scholarships are subject to document verification and Committee approval.
